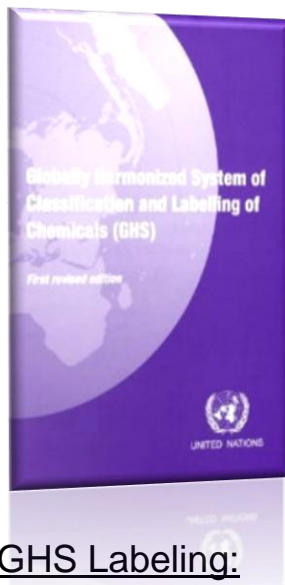

What is GHS?



The Globally Harmonized System is Classification and Labeling of petro chemicals. Since chemicals affect our lives and are essential to our health and our lifestyle, GHS was developed as an international guideline to address the classification and communication surrounding hazardous materials and protective measures. This will help to ensure the safe use of chemicals as they move through their lifecycles from “cradle to grave”.

GHS Labeling:

GHS guidelines have driven, not only the required information displayed on the labels, but also the way these labels are made. Chemical container labels must comply with specific material standards (BS 5609) allowing them to withstand the extreme toxins from the container filling process and the rough handling of the containers while in their harsh industrial environment. Most importantly, the images on the label must be remain durable throughout the label's life cycle.



On Demand Imaging:

With the vast assortment of pictograms, symbols and sizes that GHS requires for labels, the most cost effective way for chemical companies to label their product is by on-site, digital laser imaging. Therefore, these labels must comply with GHS, withstand the heat of hot laser printers (400° F), and protect the images and content they are conveying.
